Welcome to the APA Speakers Network 2009--a directory of over 200 U.S. psychologists ready to share their expertise with others. The speakers are all experts on their topics, among the 5% of APA members elected a "fellow" of APA, based on their "unusual and outstanding contributions to psychology." These include some of the premier psychologists in the USA--many leaders in their field, textbook authors, and at least four past-Presidents of the Association.

This directory is arranged by U.S. zip code, so local groups can quickly find experts in their region. It lists each expert's name, best E-address (or phone contact), their Webpage if any, and some of their key Topics. In addition, a code in the upper right indicates experts' availability as:


- S= Speaker, to h (high schools), u (universities/colleges), g (community groups), c (corporations)
- M= Mass media, as an expert on their topic
- A= Advisor, to s (students) or c (colleagues)
- H= Host, to show student groups their lab (l), clinic (c), or other on-site facility.
- L= Language fluency besides English

Topics span the full range of psychology- science, practice, teaching, consulting, advocacy. Some topics are general- such as stress, aging, sexuality, child-rearing, faith. Others are specific- such as crib death, airport screening, sleep inertia, laterality. Still others are highly practical for students and professionals- such as licensure, careers, teaching, ethics, publishing.
